WHEREAS, the Weatherization Assistance Program is the nation's largest residential energy efficiency program, initiated in 1976 in response to the energy shortage; and

WHEREAS, the Weatherization Assistance Program uses advanced technologies to determine the energy conservation needs of a home, conducts computerized energy audits, and delivers improvements to low-income families' homes, including caulking and sealing cracks and holes, insulating and making other repairs with the purpose of providing more energy efficient homes; and

WHEREAS, the Weatherization Assistance Program has produced energy cost reductions in more than 3,900 homes, affecting thousands of people, many of whom are elderly, disabled or children; and

WHEREAS, the Weatherization Assistance Program not only assists families working toward self-sufficiency, but also contributes to the improvements and progress of communities by eliminating carbon emissions, reducing dependence on foreign oil, stimulating local economies, creating jobs, and stabilizing neighborhoods;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C.L. "BUTCH" OTTER, Governor of the State of Idaho, do hereby proclaim October 30, 2010 to be

in Idaho.
