All events will take place at the parking lot located at Southface's main campus. The address for this location is:

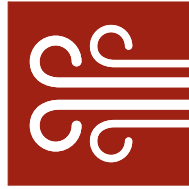

COMPETITION MATERIALS

DUCT SEALING

Southface will provide the following materials:

- Mastic
- Gloves
- Mastic brushes
- Zip ties
- Foil tape
- Mesh tape

Southface will not provide the following materials:

- Tensioning tools
- Crimpers
- Personal protective equipment

SIDEWALL INSULATOR

Southface will provide the following materials:

- Insulation
- Plugs
- Siding zip tools

Southface will not provide the following materials:

- Blower
- Generator— competitors are responsible for their own power source
- Hoses
- Drills
- Personal protective equipment

ATTIC PREP

Southface will provide the following materials:

- Caulk
- One-part foam with one foam gun
- Survey flags
- Foam board
- Drywall
- Fiberglass batts
- Flashing
- Screws

Southface will not provide the following materials:

- Two-part foam
- Personal protective equipment
- Power tools such as screw guns, saws, etc.
- Hand tools such as utility knives, shears, staple guns, etc.

Competitors are welcome to bring any tools, materials, or supplies that they typically use in the field. For example, two-part foam may be brought and used during the attic prep competition, but it is not a material that we will provide for the event. All considerations will be made to ensure fair and consistent judging regardless of materials chosen.
