A Proclamation


Declaring Weatherization Day in Martin County, Florida

- Whereas,** the month of October is National Weatherization Month and the 30th of October is National Weatherization Day; and
- Whereas,** Indiantown Non-Profit Housing, Inc. is the weatherization program provider for Martin County, the Treasure Coast, and the Palm Beaches; and
- Whereas,** over \$448,000 has been invested in weatherizing Martin County homes over the past year through this federally funded program; and
- Whereas,** since October 2009, 79 Martin County home weatherizations have been completed, 18 are in process and 22 are pending; and
- Whereas,** Indiantown Non-Profit Housing, Inc. assists approximately 64 low-income households in our region every month by making their homes more energy efficient and reducing their energy costs.


