WHEREAS, the State of Kansas has administered the Weatherization Assistance Program since its inception in 1976, providing a variety of state and federal resources through community action agencies, housing authorities, migrant farm worker programs, and departments of local government that serve people in most counties in the state; and

WHEREAS, it is important to recognize the importance of those programs that ensure that all residents, especially those living at or below the federal poverty level, have the opportunity to live in energy efficient, healthy, safe, and comfortable homes as provided for by the Weatherization Assistance Program:
