WHEREAS, October is National Energy Awareness Month, and October 30, 2013 is National Weatherization Day; and

WHEREAS, the increasing cost of energy has a major impact on low-income families, making the Weatherization Assistance Program a vital resource in conservation and relief; and

WHEREAS, the state of Washington has a long standing commitment to conserve energy resources and has administered the Weatherization Assistance Program since its inception in 1978, providing a variety of state and federal resources through community action agencies, housing authorities, and departments of local government that serve people in every county in our state; and

WHEREAS, it is important to recognize the value of those programs that ensure that all residents, especially those living at or below the federal poverty level, have the opportunity to live in energy efficient, healthy, safe, and comfortable homes as provided for by the Weatherization Assistance Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jay Inslee, Governor of the state of Washington, do hereby proclaim October 30, 2013 as

in Washington, and I urge all people in our state to join me in this special observance.
