Responding to the 1973 energy crisis, he conceived the idea of insulating homes of low-income families and funded a pilot project that was the first step in establishing the comprehensive federal Weatherization Assistance Program.

The Richard M. Saul Lifetime Achievement Award was established in 2005 by the Weatherization Assistance Program network in recognition of the founding role of Dick Saul in creating the federal low-income energy efficiency movement and reducing the energy burden facing the nation's low-income families. His creative spark ignited the Weatherization network.

In 2007 the award was presented to Greg Reamy, former U.S. Department of Energy employee. This year the award will again be given to honor an individual who best exemplifies the qualities that Dick Saul brought to his work:

Creativity in serving low-income communities;

Intelligence in program design; and,

Unrelenting focus on meeting the challenges facing America's low-income families.
