The South Central Community Action Partnership (SCCAP) would like to invite anyone interested to attend a weatherization demonstration project sponsored by the U.S. Department of Energy located at Prestwick Senior Apartment Complex, 1285 South Lincoln, Jerome Id. from 11:00AM to 2:00PM. Guest speakers from Washington, DC, Ameer Bishay, Deputy Director of Weatherization Services, National Association for State Community Services Programs and Chris Ischay from the Idaho National Laboratories will be speaking on Idaho's energy future. In 2009, SCCAP received over 4 million dollars from the American Recovery Reinvestment Act for its low-income weatherization program. This funding has enabled SCCAP to complete 239 homes so far in 2010. Nationally, weatherization agencies are hard at work every day helping to weatherize the homes of families who are struggling to meet their most basic needs. For many of these families, finances are stretched so tightly, that they must choose between feeding their family or heating their home.
