PROCLAMATION
BY THE
GOVERNOR

TO THE PEOPLE OF KANSAS, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, October is National Energy Action Month, and October 30th is designated as National Weatherization Day; and

WHEREAS, the State of Kansas has a long-standing commitment to conserve its resources and to help low-income households through its Weatherization Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, the State of Kansas has administered the Weatherization Assistance Program since its inception in 1976, providing a variety of state and federal resources and utility donations through community action agencies, not for profit entities, and departments of local government that serve people in every county in the state; and

WHEREAS, it is important to recognize the importance of those programs that ensure that all residents, especially those living at or below the federal poverty level, have the opportunity to live in energy efficient, healthy, safe, and comfortable homes as provided for by the Weatherization Assistance Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jeff Colyer, M.D., GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF KANSAS, do hereby proclaim October 2018 and October 30, 2018 as:

“Energy Action Month” and “Weatherization Day”
