

DATA Task Force Updates

The DATA TF successfully held a conference session on measurement tools at the recent MLTC conference.



- The Analysis Committee completed a one-pager on Analysis Tools that is being sent to OCS this week.
- They are also looking at options of doing network webinars.

2020 CSBG Funding

- Continuing Resolution funds from October 1-November 21 have been released
- Second CR funds from November
 22-December 20 have been released to some states
- CSBG was appropriated \$740 million for FY 2020; a \$15 million increase over 2019
 - OCS working to determine if funds can be released all together, vs quarter by quarter



ACSI



- The ACSI is available for State Administrators to take through January 24, 2020
 - Contact Roneika Carr if you have not received your ACSI Survey
- This is the opportunity to provide OCS feedback about their performance and customer service to the network

CSBG Disaster Relief Supplemental

- \$25 Million appropriation to CSBG to be administered in 17 states, 1 territory
 - Released in three phases
 - Phase One applications submitted in December
 - Phase Two applications due in March
 - NASCSP providing staff
 support for Disaster Relief
 Supplemental
 Administrators Work Group

Workgroups

- NASCSP Groups:
 - State Office ROMA Professional Peer Group
 - Reconvening in February
 - State Reporting Period Workgroup
 - Completed a survey and NASCSP is reviewing to identify tools and resources for the States.
 - There is a possibility that OCS will postpone the change, however NASCSP is moving forward to be prepared.
 - ACSI Best Practices Workgroup
 - Convened for states with highest scores or significant improvements to ID best practices

Legislative Update

Appropriations

- Congress released a spending package late December made up of "minibus" bills which finalize 2020 funding amounts
- House and Senate passed, President Trump signed into law on December 20th
- Increases for a lot of programs touching the CSBG Network



Legislative Update

Appropriations

- CSBG- \$740 million
 - Increase of \$15 million over FY 2019
- **WAP-** \$308.5 million
 - Increase of \$51.5 million over FY 2019
- LIHEAP- \$3.74 billion
 - Increase of \$50 million over FY 2019
- Head Start- \$10.6 billion
 - This is a increase of \$550 million over FY
 2019



Legislative Update

Reauthorization

- CSBG Reauthorization gaining co-sponsors in the House (141 right now)
 - Have not been any hearings held on the bill
 - CSBG reauthorization has not yet been introduced in Senate
 - NASCSP working with Executive Board
 - NCAF presented to House Poverty & Opportunity Caucus
- WAP Reauthorization- House and Senate energy committees each passed a version of reauthorization
 - Vote before full House & Senate won't happen this year. Sometime next year.
 - 116th Congress lasts until Jan. 2021





ANNUAL REPORT UPDATE

CSBG Annual Report Update

- Where are we now:
 - NASCSP is supporting OCS in the data review.
 - NASCSP completed a QA review of Modules 2 and 4.
 - OCS is completing a final review and will be sending review packages to states directly from their Program Specialist
 - This means that the data is not final.



CSBG Annual Report Update

- Where are we now:
 - OCS is planning to give states about two weeks to review the questions, complete any needed follow-up with agencies, and respond to OCS.
 - We used SmartForms to complete the review. We did not comment on any issues that SmartForms have caught, but are asking states to use the SmartForms to review data for accuracy and make a confirmation of the accuracy.
 - States using a statewide database system will receive populated SmartForms for their agencies to review the data.

CSBG Annual Report Update

- Where are we going:
 - Working with OCS to test the FY19 reporting forms and XML against OLDC
 - You can expect to see:
 - » OMB Clearance technical edits
 - » Improved comment fields!
 - » Updates to field names in the XML
 - SmartForms will not be released to states until the second OMB Clearance comment period has posted and final testing has been completed.



CSBG PERFORMANCE MANAGEMENT WEBSITE

CSBG Performance Management Website

- NASCSP is supporting OCS in the development of the CSBG Performance Management Website that will highlight state level CSBG data.
- States will be able to pull reports with graphs and charts and query the system for information found in state plans and Module 1.
- The website will be released only to states first prior to the general public.
- There will eventually be a public and private side.



OMB CLEARANCE

OMB Clearance Update

 OCS has submitted the second OMB clearance package to OMB. It will officially be posted tomorrow, starting the final 30-day comment period.

 OCS kept many of the changes to Module 1 that we saw in the first FRN, but did take the comments they received into consideration.
