Alabama LIHEAP & WAP

We call LIHEAP Weatherization "LIWAP"

Both LIHEAP and Weatherization are housed in the same State Agency and in the same Division

LIHEAP is administered by 22 CAA's

Weatherization is administered by 13 CAA's

Generally receive about \$2,000,000 in LIHEAP funds to provide weatherization

Currently blending DOE and LIHEAP funds for weatherization

Background

Prior to ARRA LIHEAP funds were used in WAP

During ARRA no LIHEAP funds for WAP

After ARRA funding slowly returned, \$1,000,000 each year

Remained completely separate from DOE

Eligibility: WAP 200% LIWAP 150%

Very little collaboration between programs

Today

This program year is the first where we have blended LIHEAP and WAP funds

Agencies have freedom to choose how it is used

Provides more flexibility

Both programs use 200% of poverty level

Mostly under DOE WAP rules

- Not subject to statewide average
- Not subject to DOE SIR standards

Reweatherization a possibility


Lessons Learned
