Energy OutWest Virtual Experience, organized by Energy OutWest and sponsored by the US Department of Energy (DOE), is being held August 11-13, 2020. This virtual training conference, offering live sessions each day, is designed to bring Weatherization providers, energy professionals, and private partners together for an opportunity to share knowledge, skills, and information on best practices in the energy services market, specifically weatherization.
