



# NAVIGATING THE CONFERENCE VIRTUAL PLATFORM – Town Hall




After logging in, you will be taken into the **Town Hall**. This is the main landing page where attendees can access all the conference platform features.

# NAVIGATING THE CONFERENCE VIRTUAL PLATFORM – Activity Stream




**Activity Stream** is where attendees can collectively communicate with each other, post photos, messages, comment and like other posts, and more. Think of it as your conference Facebook page

**Bio**


