Utah: State Community Services Office

- Disbursed **FY19 and FY20 discretionary**—based on formula
 - *Immediate, flexible resource*
- Updated CSBG Policies:
 - **Used memos**—flexible and could be issued as needed
 - *Self-declaration of income*
 - *Electronic signature allowed for recorded phone application*
- Weekly/bi-weekly meetings
 - *clear communication/coordinate with other meetings (RAP/HAP)*
- CSBG CARES application (opened April 2020)
 - *abbreviated needs assessment embedded*
- Participation in Rental Assistance and Housing Assistance programs (**RAP/HAP**)
 - *Division decision to use CAAs as one stop shop—emergency rental assistance: ESG, HOME and State CARES funds*
 - *Immediate concern May 15 deadline—eviction protection*
