# Government Funding

- Current Continuing Resolution
  - Through December 3<sup>rd</sup>
  - More CR's possible
    - Each CR releases portions of funds based on prior years funds.
    - **Make sure to use same wording and funding amounts from prior year.**
    - NASCSP will continue to monitor and communicate to members.





# Government Funding

- FY22 Appropriations
  - HR 4549
    - \$834 Million
    - 200% Eligibility
  - S 3062
    - \$800 Million
    - 200% Eligibility
- Reconciliation

- Next steps – Subcommittee and Full Committee Markup



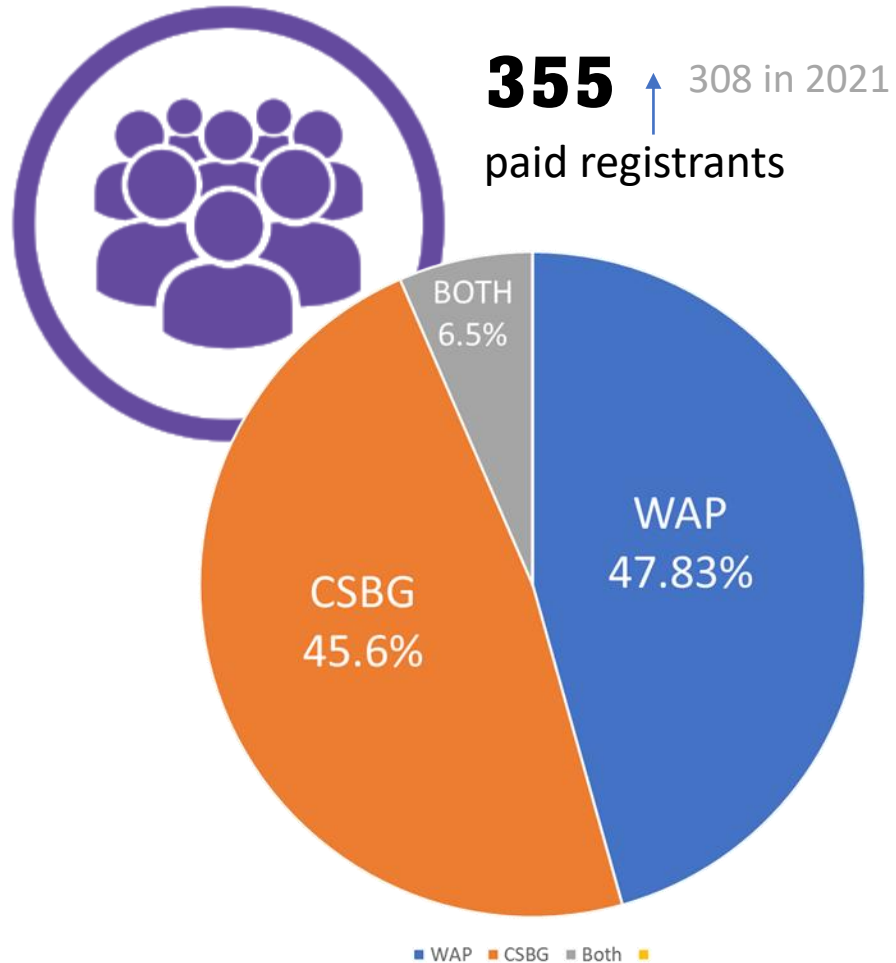

# NCAF Reporting Conversation

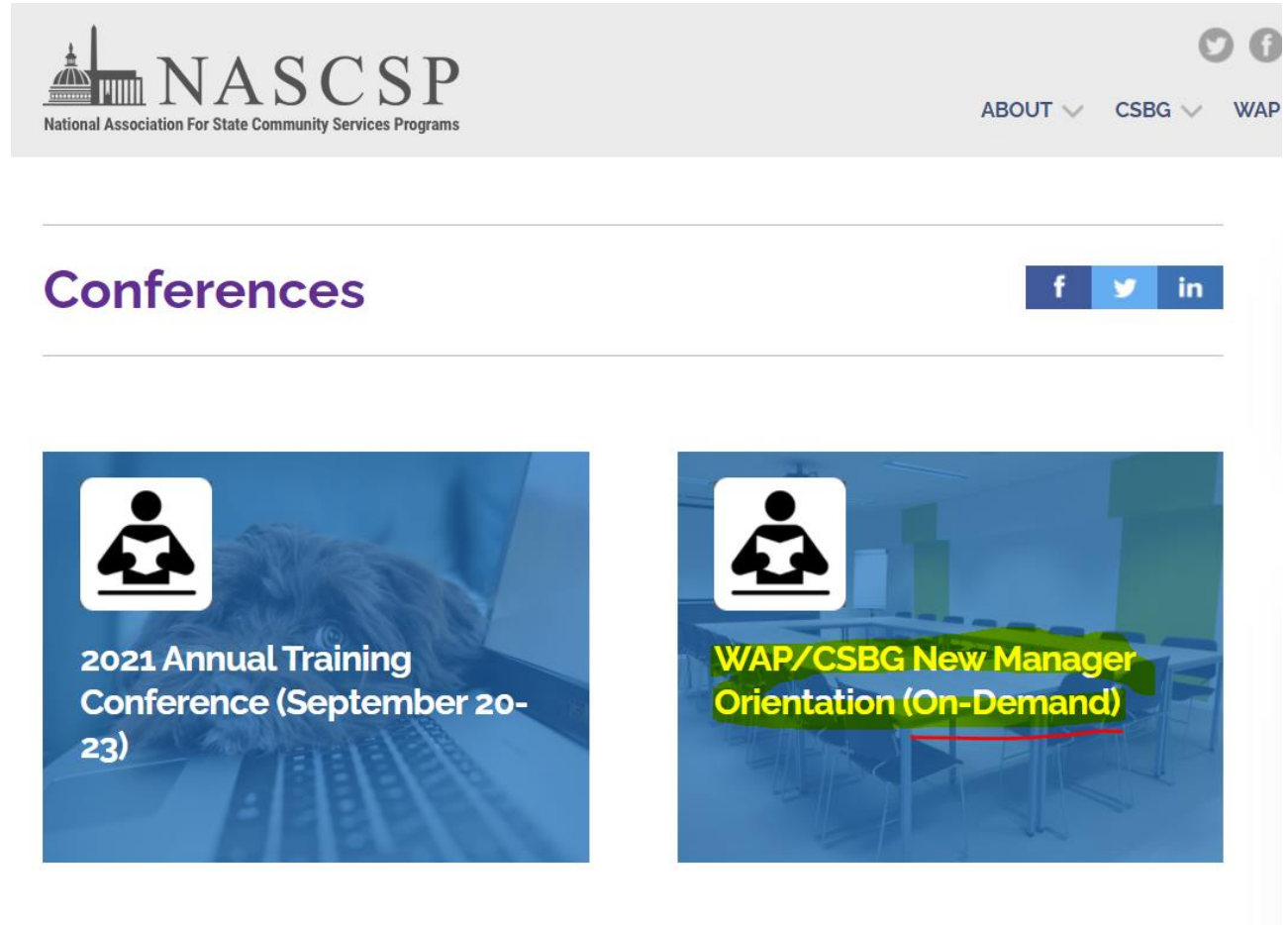
- The panel included:

- Takeaways
  - CSBG is a funding stream so it's not a "dollars for outcomes" type of program.
  - The Annual Report helps agencies get an agency-wide view of their programs so that they can assess their programs and adjust as needed, per ROMA principles.
  - The report can be time-consuming and challenging because of data interoperability issues.
  - There should be data standards at the national level that make it easier for agencies to not duplicate work and bring it all together.
