






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CSBG CARES Remaining Balance by Region

State Roles and Responsibilities

It falls to the state to determine allowability and eligibility parameters

- Eligibility *does not* have to be *directly* tied to COVID-19 infection
- Everyone has been *impacted* by COVID at this point
- A Few Examples:
 - Inflation-Gas and Food Price Increases
 - Missed Wages/Unemployment/Reduced Hours
 - Child Care Closures and Price Increases
 - Deaths in the Family

State Roles and Responsibilities

States can and *should* be flexible

- Expediting Contract Amendments/Modifications
 - Work Plans
 - Budgets
- Abbreviated Community Needs Assessments and/or CAP plans
- Advances vs Reimbursements


