Each year, the WAP Grantees report comprehensive funding and production data to NASCSP. This important survey is required to complete the PY 2022 Annual Funding Report that goes to Congress and our Federal Funding partners. The PY 2022 Annual Funding Survey is intended for:

- **April 1 Grantees:** April 1, 2022 - March 30, 2023
- **July 1 Grantees:** July 1, 2022 - June 30, 2023
- **BIL Grantees:** July 1, 2022 - June 30, 2023
