2023 Continuous Improvement Workshop

Identified needs for:

- Clear understanding of U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) requirements for multifamily weatherization.
- A centralized resource "hub" for multifamily weatherization.
- Help with outreach and relationship building with multifamily building owners and managers.
- Technical training resources:
 - Measure installation.
 - Diagnostic testing.
 - Utility bill analysis.
- Research and communication resources for non-energy impacts (NEI) of multifamily weatherization (indoor air quality and health benefits in particular).

 - ✓ New Mexico Sub-Grantee for WAP MF and Statewide HUD HH Production Grantee
 - ✓ Connecticut WAP Sub-Grantee for MF Statewide, Barrier Remediation Program Provider, HUD HH and WAP Demonstration Grantee
 - ✓ Tennessee WAP Sub-Grantee for MF
 - ✓ Michigan WAP Sub-Grantee for MF
 - ✓ MF Utility/State/Local Government Program Provider in multiple states



Why Multifamily WAP?



√ Scalability

- MF Programs can complete hundreds of units at once.
- Volume efficiencies with contractors and qualification process

✓ Equity

- Data shows a large amount of the LI population live in MF housing
- ACEEE notes that the MF market is typically "underserved" by energy programs





Should you Consider MF WAP?

>Rural vs Urban?

✓ Rural states HAVE been successful with MF programs

≻Housing Stock?

✓ Most states have enough multifamily affordable housing to target with WAP. Ask your housing finance authority.

≻Gaps and Synergies

✓ Does your State have successful utility programs serving LI renters in MF. Is the State going to start investing resources via DOE rebates or other sources towards MF?





MF Program: Where to Start

- ✓ Assess your Current Subgrantees
 - Who has tackled MF?
 - Who has capacity to take on any new initiatives
 - Who serves areas with high amounts of MF



- √ Have you worked with DOE on MF Projects before?
- √How difficult would it be to add new Subgrantee's to your WAP?



✓What Housing Partners and Stakeholders do you need?



Program Design

✓ Updates to your State Plan and Program

- ❖ Work with housing partners to make categorical eligibility changes for MF
- Ensure Low Rise Multifamily Priority Lists can be utilized
- Plan on updating program guidelines and manuals
- Planning around MF audit tools

✓ Determine Program Model

- 3rd Party Implementor?
- Train existing Subgrantees?
