The National Association for State and Community Service Programs (NASCSPP) 2024 Annual Conference will take place September 16-20, 2024 in Memphis, Tennessee which includes pre-conference training opportunities. Attendance at this event is considered an allowable use of the training and technical assistance (T&TA) funds by the Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) network organizations.

The conference features a WAP Track which aims to provide a wealth of information, tools, and resources to enhance and improve Grantee administration and implementation practices including multiple sessions with Department of Energy (DOE) WAP leadership/managers (DOE Federal Perspective and DOE Live Question and Answers). These sessions will provide updates and insights on current and upcoming WAP activities while engaging attendees in critical dialogue at all levels of the program. Additional core conference offerings will include fiscal, technical, programmatic content, and workshops which include Federal Partner and National Partner updates on important WAP topics.
