
## **Multifamily Weatherization Survey**

DOE Special Request - May 2024


A NASCSP information request regarding multifamily weatherization distributed to the WAP network received responses from 17 Grantees and three Subgrantees. The purpose of this survey was to provide information for a Whitehouse Information Request to understand the makeup of multifamily housing funds and their distribution throughout the network. This survey was promoted to the network via NASCSP's bi-weekly WAP E-News, two dedicated Constant Contact email blasts, and during the Quarterly Member Webinar held May 9<sup>th</sup>.


**Dwellings completed by Funding Source:** respondents were asked what funding source(s) are being used for multifamily weatherization and could choose from DOE Formula, DOE BIL, LIHEAP, Utility, or Other. The responses have been broken out by building type (2 – 4, Small Multifamily, Large Multifamily).











For comparison, the three graphs above have been combined to show differences between funding types and multifamily building types.




**Workscope Development:** to assess the rate of adoption of DOE's Streamlined Priority Lists for small multifamily weatherization respondents were asked what percentage of small multifamily work is completed with DOE Priority Lists, energy audits, or Grantee developed Priority Lists.




**Grantee Capacity:** to determine the capacity at the Grantee level, respondents were asked if additional Grantee staff have been hired to manage multifamily projects and if they had existing staff dedicated to multifamily work.




**Subgrantee Capacity:** Grantees and Subgrantees were asked if additional Subgrantees and contracting companies had been added to their network to perform multifamily weatherization.



**Technician Capacity:** to better understand who is completing the multifamily weatherization work, we asked which Subgrantees are performing multifamily work, and which measures they provide.



**Barriers:** survey respondents were asked which barriers they have encountered when implementing multifamily weatherization.



**Training Needs:** respondents were asked what their greatest training needs are related to multifamily weatherization.
