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Introduction

Each year, the WAP Grantees report comprehensive funding and production data to NASCSP. This important survey is required to complete the PY 2023 Annual Funding Report that goes to Congress and our Federal Funding partners. The PY 2023 Annual Funding Survey is intended for:

- April 1 Grantees: April 1, 2023 March 30, 2024
- July 1 Grantees: July 1, 2023 June 30, 2024
- BIL Grantees: July 1, 2023 June 30, 2024



Section 2 – Other (Non-Federal) Funds

Other Funds are those received from non-federal sources that were incorporated into the weatherization program.



Table 1: Definitions of Other Funds Categories

Type of Funding	Definition	Example
Utility	Any funds that utilities contribute to your WAP <u>and</u> come through your state agency.	Utility company providing the funds (e.g. ComEd, National Grid, utility public benefit fund, etc.)
State	Funds that come from state-collected revenues such as fees or tax revenues. Any funding from state general revenues or appropriated to WAP by the state legislature are included here as well.	State budget, Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative, etc.
Miscellaneous	Any funds that do not fit in the "Utility" or "State" categories <u>and</u> come through the state agency.	Donation from a foundation, Funding from a health insurance company, etc.






