SUBJECT: Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) WAP Sustainable Energy Resources for Consumers (SERC) **Selections**

Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) Grantees, Subgrantees

The U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) has selected 14 Grantees to receive approximately \$53 million in SERC BIL funds. The SERC BIL Grant Application Memorandum 117 was published on November 1, 2023 in support of section 40551 of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) of 2021, also known as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL), and the broader government-wide approach to deploy demonstration projects that maximize the benefits of the clean energy transition as the nation works to curb the climate crisis, empower workers, and advance environmental justice.

The 14 Grantees were selected to expand DOE's existing weatherization program by utilizing BIL SERC to install renewable energy systems and other technologies and solutions not typically covered under WAP to perform deep energy retrofits of low-income residential buildings.

SERC is authorized per Title IV of the Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007 (EISA), Section 411(b) (Pub. L. 110–140, title IV, §411(b), Dec. 19, 2007, 121 Stat. 1600). DOE's Secretary may elect to use up to two (2) percent of the amount of funds made available for SERC grants when WAP appropriated funds exceed \$275 million. This provision authorizes local weatherization providers to expand the Program for "materials, benefits, and renewable and domestic energy technologies not currently covered."
