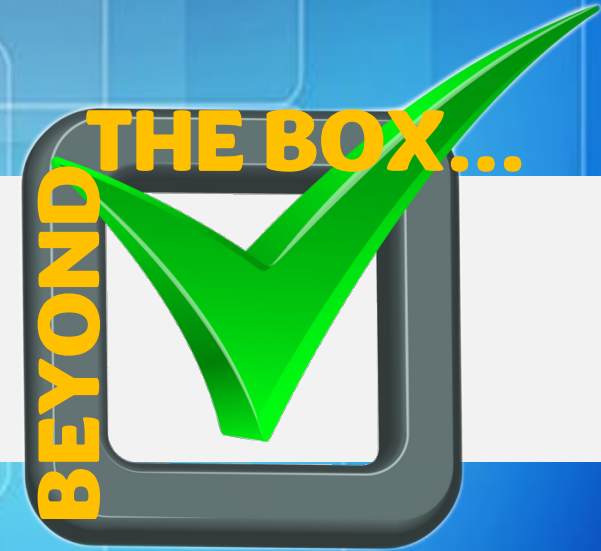

State Office – CSBG Team

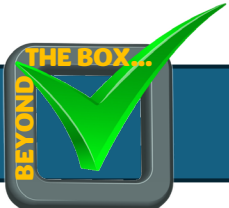
- Federal and Two State Community Services Block Grant (\$9M Federal, \$1M State and \$2M State)

State Office- CSBG staff administer over 200 individual grants

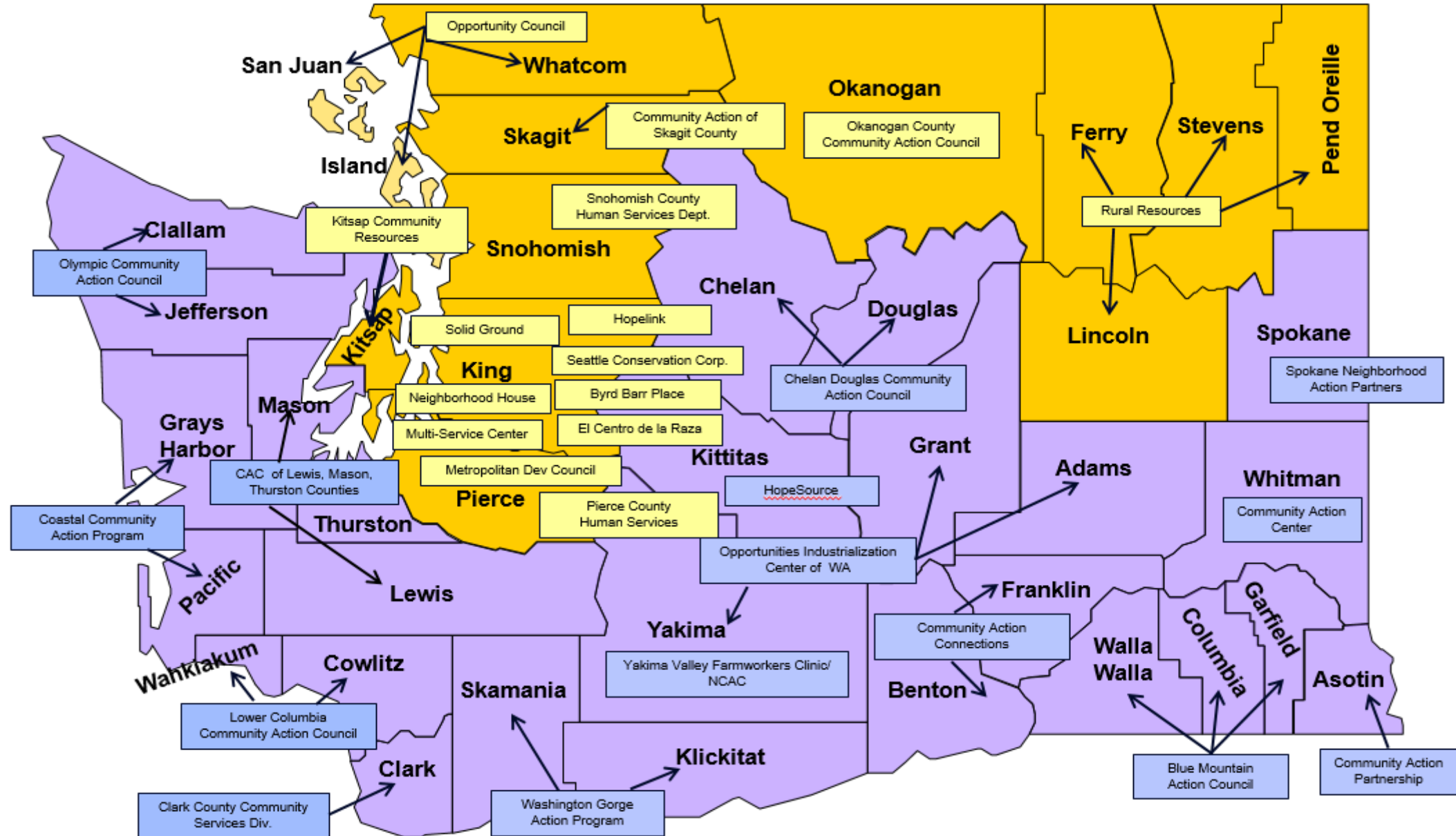
- 60 State CSBG (2 grants per CAA)

CSBG Map

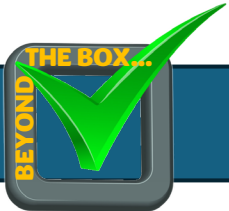

- *State Association Partnership funded by CSBG, LIHEAP, and WX*



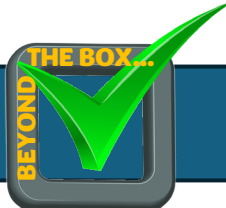
Nevada Department of Health and Human Services – Grants Management Unit

The Grants Management Unit resides within the Nevada DHHS' Director's Office and oversees the Community Services Block Grant.

Monitoring staff includes 1 Program staff member and 1 Fiscal staff member supported by contract and administrative employees.

FFY24 CSBG Allocation for Nevada \$4,021,915:

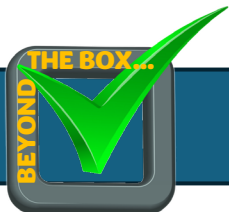
- \$ 3,619,723 Pass-through allocated to 12 Community Action Agencies;
- \$ 201,096 Administration allocated for >1 FTE, operating & administrative expenses; and
- \$ 201,096 Discretionary allocated to the Nevada Community Action Association and training.
