Introduction

October 30 is National Weatherization Day, an annual opportunity to highlight the impacts of the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE)
Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP).
Over the past 48 years, WAP has helped improve more than 7 million homes, reducing energy costs for families, enhancing safety and comfort, and creating stable jobs that strengthen local economies and cannot be outsourced.



The National Association for State Community Services Programs (NASCSP) proudly supports these celebrations by providing resources and tools to amplify Weatherization Day activities nationwide. This year, NASCSP staff attended events across the country, gaining a firsthand view of how weatherization strengthens households and bolsters local economies.

Alongside these in-person efforts, Weatherization Day generates significant virtual engagement, including proclamations, press coverage, and social media activity. These campaigns raise awareness about WAP's successes, demonstrating that Weatherization saves money, improves lives, and supports the local workforce.



Public Information Campaign Kickoff

The National Association for State Community Services Programs (NASCSP) began sending communications regarding the 2024 Weatherization Day Public Information Campaign in mid-July. These initial communications were to advertise the Weatherization Day Kickoff webinar with the National Partners.

On August 29, 2024, NASCSP held a webinar with the National Community Action Partnership (NCAP) and the National Community Action Foundation (NCAF) to introduce and promote the NASCSP WAP Outreach and Site Demonstration Toolkits. The intended audience of the webinar was WAP grantees and subgrantees. The webinar was attended by approximately 200 people. Resources



NASCSP promotes the use of two key resources in preparation for Weatherization Day. These are the Weatherization Day 2024 Outreach Toolkit and the Weatherization Day 2024 Site Demonstration Toolkit. The Toolkits were updated for 2024 and made available on the NASCSP website.

Resources included in the Toolkits range from tips on telling impactful Weatherization stories to templates on how to engage policy makers, and successful strategies for live Weatherization Day events. The Weatherization Day Outreach Toolkit includes dozens of sample social media posts and numerous pages of images to use in those posts and other initiatives. Additionally, the Weatherization Day Outreach Toolkit includes a full timeline and how to report activities to ensure they are captured. The Site Demonstration Toolkit covers everything from virtual demonstrations to site selection, including equipment lists, sample agendas press kit materials, and examples of successful demonstrations. These two Toolkits are designed to make participating in Weatherization Day accessible and replicable, outcomes that have clearly been met in 2024.



Resources



The 2024 Weatherization Day campaign included a strategic communications calendar to organize communications efforts throughout October and outlined weekly themes leading up to Weatherization Day.

In celebration of Weatherization Day, NASCSP staff joined events across the United States, standing alongside local agencies, community partners, and program participants to recognize the profound impact of Weatherization programs.

Maine Weatherization Day

In southern Maine, the York Country Community Action Corp., Maine Housing, and the Sanford School System partnered on an event held at the Sanford Regional Technical School where presenters had the opportunity to talk about the Weatherization field with high-school-age students who are interested in the building trades. Attendees were provided the chance to see some of the Weatherization tools, discuss starting a business



with vendors, and learn the basics of Weatherization. This was an exciting opportunity to talk about Weatherization careers and business opportunities with young people interested in the building trades.

Great Lakes Community Action Partnership (GLCAP)









The Great Lakes Community Action
Partnership (GLCAP) hosted a
Weatherization Day event in Fremont
Ohio at the home of a recently
weatherized client's home. During the
event staff discussed and
demonstrated insulation methods,
furnace inspection, infrared testing and
other aspects of Weatherization. In
attendance was U.S. Representative
Marcy Kaptur (OH) who shared

remarks highlighting the importance and impact of the Weatherization Assistance Program. In 2023, GLCAP weatherized 174 homes in its service area.

New Hampshire Weatherization Day

On October 25th, the New Hampshire
Department of Energy hosted a Weatherization
Day celebration at the Lakes Region Community
College in Laconia, New Hampshire. This event
featured hands-on demonstrations, educational
sessions, and vendors from the energy sector.
Attendees had the opportunity to see spray
foam and dense-pack insulation installations
along with other air-sealing training props. This
event featured opportunities for technicians to



learn and for job seekers to find out more about the Weatherization field.

Corporation for Ohio Appalachian Development (COAD) / Ohio Weatherization Training Center Unveil Solar Initiatives

The Corporation for Ohio Appalachian Development (COAD) held an open house showcasing COAD's Ohio Weatherization Training Center (OWTC) and celebrated the 48th Weatherization Day. The Weatherization Day event included a presentation of Gov. Mike DeWine's Weatherization Day Proclamation and a tour of the OWTC including emerging solar initiatives secured through U.S. Department of Energy Sustainable Resources for Consumers (SERC) grants. The event brought together partners, member agencies, trainers, former students, and public officials to see first-hand how men and women are trained for lucrative Weatherization careers. The OWTC trains more than 1,000 men and women annually at its main facility in Athens and at satellite facilities in Dayton and Newark.











Association for Energy Affordability (AEA) Weatherization Day

Weatherization, hosted a fullday Weatherization Day
event at their Bronx location.
AEA opened with a
presentation by Heather
Nolen and El Niang on
Leveraging Data to Optimize
Weatherization Outcomes,
highlighting how
Weatherization can lead to
significant energy savings

for low-income clients. A dynamic panel discussion followed, led by Francis Rodriguez, AEA; Edwin Mendez, New York City Housing Authority; and Caleb Smith, WE ACT for Environmental Justice, who explored Advancements in Sustainability and the Future of Weatherization. The afternoon featured live demonstrations of weatherized multifamily units and the latest in energy-efficient products, including battery-powered induction stoves and advanced radiators.

Other WAP Day Events

In **Nebraska**, **California**, **Illinois**, the Community Action Partnership of Mid Nebraska, Fresno EOC Energy Services, and Community & Economic Development Association of Cook County respectively spotlighted Weatherization Day on social media. In **Colorado**, the Colorado Weatherization Assistance Program celebrated Weatherization Day by launching a home electrification and appliance rebate program and highlighted career opportunities in home energy performance.



Proclamations were issued in at least **12 states**: California, Colorado, Georgia, Kansas, Kentucky, Maine, Minnesota, New Mexico, Ohio, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, and Wisconsin. Proclamations are a meaningful way to educate decision-makers and the public about events and activities.








Today is National Weatherization Day, and we're excited to introduce you to Miss Mary! She is one of the wonderful individuals who benefited from our recent Weatherization projects at CAPNA, Last week we gathered as a team to show Mary the love and support she needed!

We first met Mary in 2023 when her home was selected for our NeighborWorks Block Makeover initiative. Unfortunately, during the ice storm in 2024, her home faced significant challenges. The storm caused her attic hot water heater to leak, leading to frozen pipes and a series of complications that ultimately left Mary without a home for several months.

When we learned about the struggles Mary was facing, it was clear that she needed our support. We were honored to include her in our Weatherization program, which allowed us to help her return home. Through this initiative, we provided over \$14,000 in home enhancements at no cost

Here are just a few of the ways we were able to make Mary's home safer and healthier.

- Installed a new hot water heater, relocating it to the ground floor for safety
- Added attic insulation and weatherstripping
- Insulated the pipes to prevent future issues
- Installed two ton mini split ductless heating and cooling unit and more!

We're grateful to have been able to support Mary on her journey back home, and we hope her story inspires others in our community.
