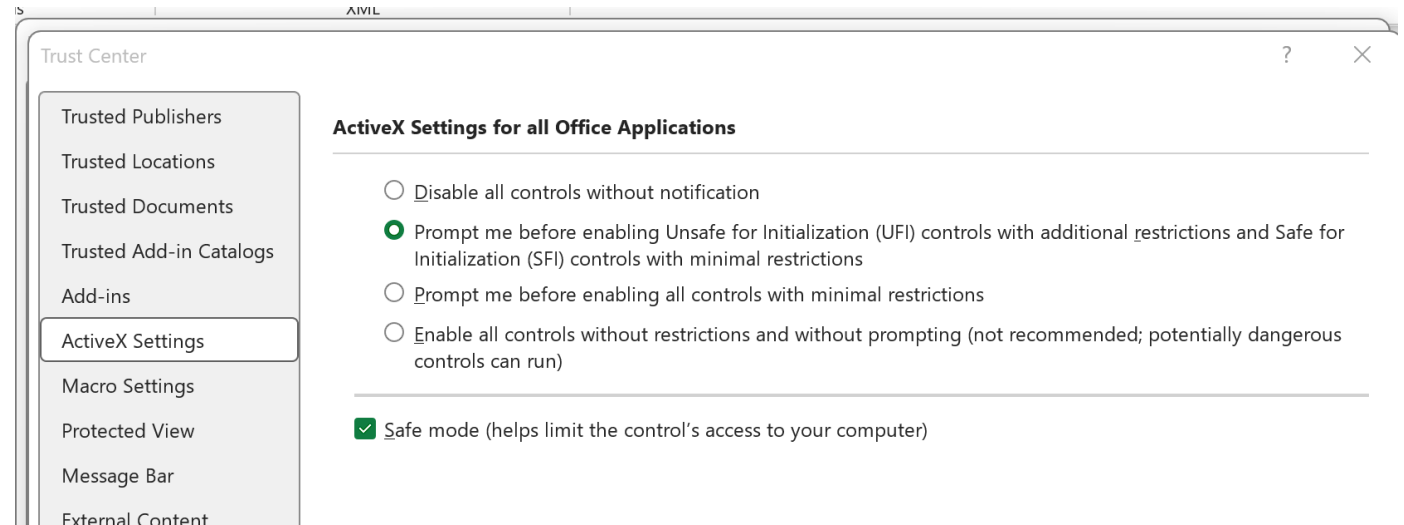
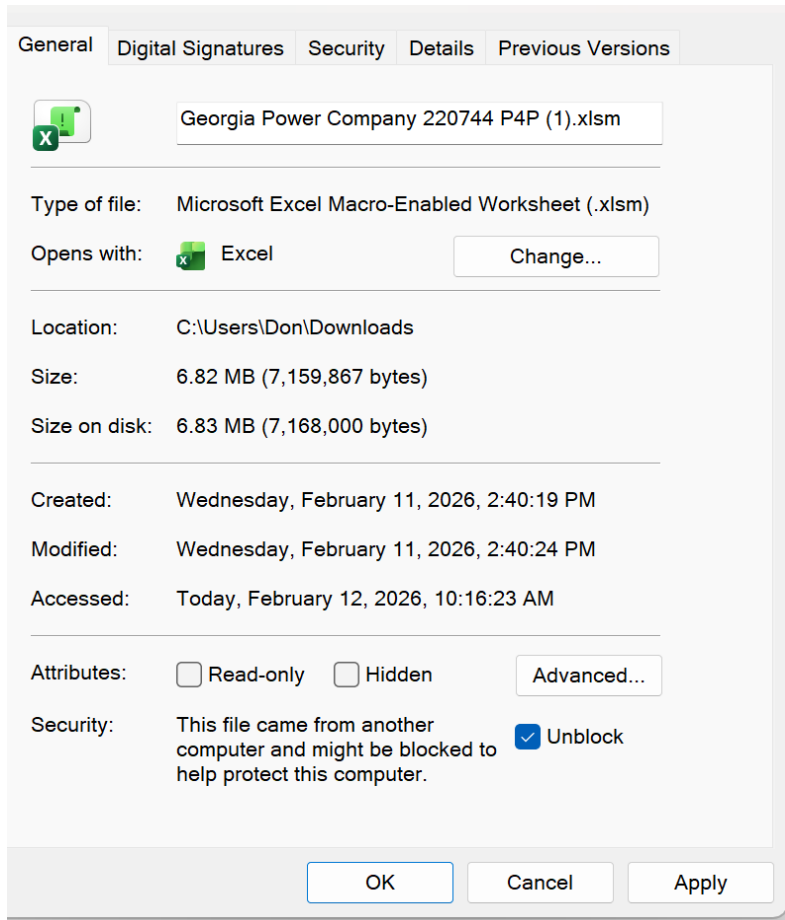
SmartForms and Issues Faced

- Auto-Calculations not always working

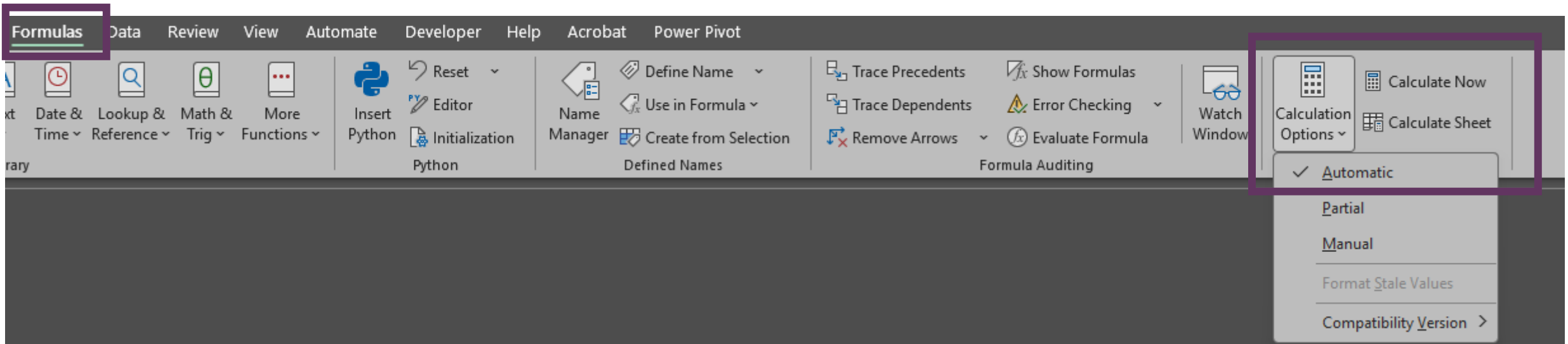
